Why your contributions matter:

- Quality Education: Our goal is to engage, challenge, and cater to each student's needs, focusing on literacy, numeracy skills, wellbeing, and personal development.
- <u>Specialist Programs:</u> We offer well-resourced programs such as Performing & Visual Arts, Physical Education, Mandarin, and the Kitchen Garden program supported by your contributions.
- <u>ICT Infrastructure:</u> We are improving our infrastructure, software, and equipment for better learning experiences for all grades, including the extension of school-managed devices.
- <u>Preserving our School:</u> Contributions help maintain the school library, heritage buildings, facilities, and grounds beyond what the government funding covers.

This year we have made some changes to parent payments:

- Extra-curricular Items & Activities have changed from a levy to PAYG. This means you will be asked to contribute for activities when they are scheduled.
- The Library Fund contribution has increased. This will be used to make a significant investment in updating ICT infrastructure.
- Our BYOD policy is changing as we are updating ICT infrastructure. The increase in the Library Fund covers the investment in more school managed devices across the school.



Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

 Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES
